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WHAT'S YOUR CURRENT JOB TITLE?

HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN WORKING IN THE INDUSTRY?

I started in property management 25 years ago as the Marketing Director of an enclosed mall in the St. James area – anyone remember Unicity Mall? After nearly five years there, I moved to Portage & Main to work for Trizec at the Commodity Exchange Building. Over 20 years later, Trizec and the Commodity Exchange Tower name are long gone, but I am still here and very happy to be working for Artis REIT at their headquarters building, 360 MAIN.

WHAT ARE SOME OF YOUR JOB RESPONSIBILITIES?

Artis REIT owns several office, retail and industrial properties across Canada and in the U.S. The team I work with manages the Portage & Main portfolio, which includes 360 MAIN office tower, MTS Place office towers (333 Main & 191 Pioneer), Winnipeg Square retail mall, and the underground Winnipeg Square Parkade. We are a small team and work together closely on most projects

to ensure the properties run efficiently and professionally. For example, we are very excited about the current building envelope modernization to 360 MAIN and the future construction of our newest building, 300 MAIN, announced in April. It will change the look of Portage & Main.

With all of the projects we manage, my main focus is to ensure the tenants remain happy and comfortable. Marketing the properties and looking at new amenities and services to keep our existing tenants happy while attracting new is all part of that. Tenants want to be in buildings that are environmentally responsible, so I work with others in our team and our tenants to research, develop, and implement sustainability initiatives at these buildings. Tenants spend a lot of their day with us; we want them to leave each day feeling good about where they work.

HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN A BOMA MEMBER?

I've been a member for a long time – I think somewhere around 13 years.

WHY DID YOU BECOME A MEMBER?

into the Marketing and Development
Committee. I also help out with the
Holiday Luncheon Committee. Being a
Board Member from 2009 to 2015 and
working closely with such great people

was a blast! I looked forward to spending time with all of them at each BOMEX, but the most fun was when we got to plan our own BOMEX right here in Winnipeg!

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE BENEFITS YOU SEE IN BECOMING A MEMBER?

Definitely meeting and networking with others who understand what you do, whether it be on committees, at educational seminars, or social events.
