What we quickly discovered is that many of the tenants of the pilot program, who had a green mandate, were already doing much of the work required to earn certification. What was missing was a blueprint which gave them the ability to record what had already been done and set a plan for continuous improvement.

There were also some surprises along the way. Gloria Young, CFO and Director of Operations at the law firm Cox & Palmer, recalls the results from the audit of the law firm's waste. To her team's dismay the largest source of waste was their garbage bags, 1/4 filled or less, being deposited in landfills. That was one of the first things rectified.
